July 2007 - National Gymnastics Summer School

Position: Jazz, Ballet and Contemporary Dance Teacher - involved taking the gymnasts in a daily dance class with emphasis on performance in their work to then incorporate in their gymnastics. I also choreographed 6 different routines for the gymnasts to perform.

September 2006 – present – Orchard House Primary School

Position: Ballet and Jazz Teacher - involves instructing RAD Ballet and Jazz dance to 6 different classes of children aged 3-12 years. I prepare the students for an end of year examination of the syllabus that they have been studying together with performance for the teachers and parents

September 2006 – present – Park Walk Primary School

Position: Ballet Teacher - involves weekly sessions on introducing ballet to a class of 4-8 year olds. I teach the fundamentals of ballet and prepare presentations at the end of the term

September 2004 – present – Stage Coach

Position: Dance, Drama and Singing Teacher - involves instructing 7-16 year olds in dance, drama and singing. I developed my own lesson plans for each field of study and for each age range. As a substitute teacher I have to quickly adapt to my surroundings and the level at which the children are working at.

September 2006 – December 2006 – Acton High School

Position: Street Jazz Teacher - I held an after school Jazz class once a week for students at the school. This role included choreographing and planning a lesson to keep all students engaged in learning.

September 2006 – April 2007 – St Thomas Primary School

Position: Ballet Teacher - I held an after-school ballet club once a week for an hour long class where I taught the RAD syllabus to a class of 20 children aged 3-9. This role included instructing the children, organising lesson plans, promoting the club and taking care of the finances.

July 2006 – Musical Theatre Workshop

Position: Teacher and Director of Musical Theatre - I conducted a day's workshop of a musical with 30 children age 8-14years. The day involved a warm-up in each area of work. and choreographing and directing the children in a short performance.

February 2004-July 2004 – Stage Coach

Position: Dance/Drama/Singing teacher - involved instructing 3-6 and 7-16 year olds in Dance, drama or singing. I developed my own lesson plans for each of the levels. As a substitute teacher I had to quickly build a good relationship with the children for a good positive working environment.

August 2002- December 2002 – Stage Coach

Position: Dance Teacher -The post involved instructing 7-16 year olds to dance. I developed my own lesson plans and worked with three different classes to teach different dance styles.
